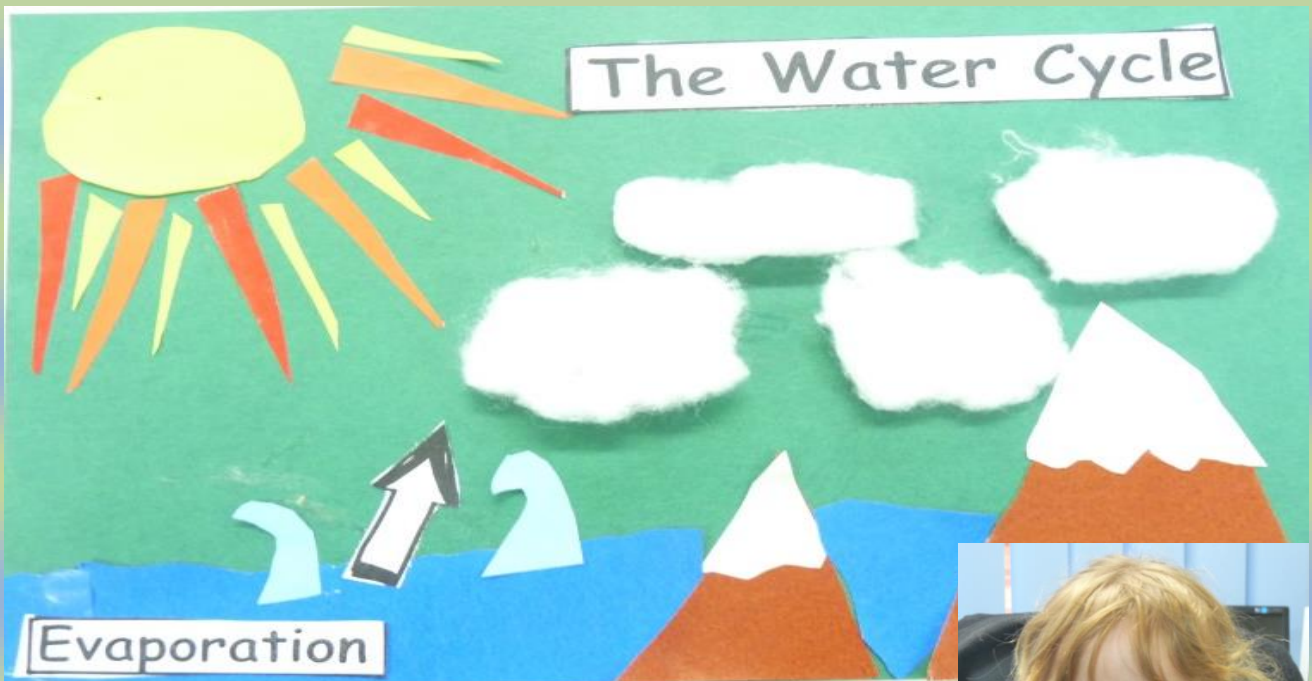


THE WATER CYCLE



In science, with Mrs Starkie, Room 5 have been learning all about the 'Water Cycle'.
