## SECONDARY SCHOOLING SCHOLARSHIPS FOR 2018 - NOW OPEN FOR APPLICATIONS

The Department of Education coordinates a range of student scholarships, grants and prizes to meet some of the costs of secondary schooling see below. Scholarships for 2018 are now open for applications.

- James and Rose Coombe Scholarships for rural and remote students. A number of these scholarships are available each year. The funding amount starts at \$1000.
- Maud Zervos Education Grants for students with a parent/caregiver who has a disability (a spinal injury with resulting paralysis or a significant limb loss or limb paralysis). A 'rollover clause' in these grants makes funding available for further years of study, subject to satisfactory attendance and progress. The funding amount starts at \$750 in lower secondary and rises to \$1000 for upper secondary studies.
