Dear Parents / Caregivers

The East Manjimup Primary School Board has endorsed the schedule of contributions and charges for 2023. The schedule is broken into two sections and will allow you to calculate all costs that you **might** incur throughout the school year.

1. VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS due 24 March 2023

The total amount of voluntary contributions parents and carers are asked to pay is \$50:00 per student, Year K to Year 6 and is well under the \$60:00 per student maximum limit set in the School Education Regulations 2000.

Money collected is used to supplement school expenditure in the areas listed and to supplement the cost of student workbooks including Origo Maths, New Wave Mental Maths and Sound Waves Spelling. While contributions are voluntary it is important to understand that these funds are used to maximise the quality of our teaching and learning programs.

- ◆ **Total Cost per student (contributions) - \$50:00**

2. CHARGES - EXTRA COST OPTIONS

A breakdown of estimated **charges** for your child's participation in incursions, excursions, activities etc. for 2023 has been included in the attached grid. Students will only incur costs when they are involved in a particular activity. The school has an expectation that all students attend events as they occur on a user pays basis. The amounts indicated on the grid represent the **maximum** that **may** be charged for scheduled activities in 2023. As in the past you will be asked to make payment for each activity as it approaches.

- ◆ **Total Cost per student (extra cost options) – between \$60.00 (Kindy) – \$963.00 (Year 6)**

***Payment for charges and contributions can be made by regular instalments or extended over a period if necessary. Please make arrangements through the school office.*

The School Board has also endorsed the Personal Items List for 2023, which has been reviewed this year to ensure uniformity across year levels
